How few around the world know Chopin's mother was Polish and his father French... Yet Chopin himself was born in the Duchy of Warsaw, an artificial state created during the Napoleonic Wars and Partitions of Poland of the 18th and 19th centuries. Poland did not exist at the time, and very few records survive centuries of European wars to show us today what Chopin's family roots were down the ages – yet what we do know is that the young Frederic often wrote about his travels around rural Poland and the Carpathian, Jewish, Kuyavian, Mazovian, Roma and other musicians and bands of international, multiethnic origin he heard during his childhood – diverse melodies and arrangements the boy genius would never forget and which would inspire the music he would go on to compose during his exile in Austria, England, France, Germany, Scotland and Spain.

How few around the globe know Elvis' ancestors came from Germany and their original surname was Pressler. It is believed they were part of the Sinti people, known as the "Black Dutch." It is also likely that from his mother's side, Smith by surname, the family would have been of Romanichel origins. Elvis's maternal great-great-grandmother was a Jewish woman named Nancy Burdine. Little is known about her, but it's believed her family immigrated to America from what is now Lithuania around the time of the American Revolution. In centuries past, Warsaw was the capital city of the Great Polish Lithuanian Commonwealth – giving Elvis and Chopin shared ancestry. Elvis was at least 1/16 (6.25%) Cherokee. His Great-great-great-grandmother, Morning White Dove, was full Cherokee.

Do dziś, zielona wywerna jest symbolem ruin zamku Mazowieckich Książąt w Czersku.


